A classic point to point, **8 mile fell race**, across the magnificent **Brontë Moors**, that starts at Wycoller Country Park near Trawden GR 933393 (South Pennines Sheet) and finishes in the doorway of the **Fleece Inn** on the old cobbled street in Haworth. The course is **very scenic**, and **entirely off-road**.

There's a bottle of Championship **Timothy Taylor's Landlord** for you at the finish, plus **soup and a roll** in the pub. Registration is at the Aisled Barn, Wycoller Country Park, where **all** race numbers will be issued. All this for **just £7.00** — payable to Keighley & Craven A. Coach transport from Haworth to the Start at Wycoller Country Park is available if you pre-enter. Please try to have your entry with us no later than October 3rd. Coach leaves Haworth (top of Rawdon Road) at **9:30am sharp**. Kit will be brought back to the finish. Or, you can **ENTER ON THE DAY** if you make your own way to Wycoller. Please only park your car in official car parks at Wycoller to avoid upsetting the locals.



To race you **MUST** have the following kit: **Waterproof cagoule and over-trousers, map, compass, whistle and fell/trail shoes**. There will be kit checks – no kit, no race. We want you to enjoy the race and stay safe.
