Coach transport from Haworth to the start is **ONLY** available if you pre-enter. Please have your entry with us no later than 15th October 2017 to book on the bus. Buses start leaving Haworth (top of Rawdon Road) at 9:30am. Kit (very small bags, please) will be brought back to the finish. You can **ENTER ON THE DAY** but you'll have to make your own way to Wycoller.

No race confirmation will be sent out to entrants (entry list will be published on kcac.co.uk), so please don't send a stamped addressed envelope. Only park your car in official car parks at Wycoller - **NOT** in residents' parking areas.
